It appearing that a pending amendment to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m), reducing the period for effecting service from 120 days to 90 days, will go into effect on December 1, 2015; therefore


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the amended time period for effecting service under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m) shall apply to all cases filed on or after December 1, 2015, to the extent practicable, unless otherwise ordered by the presiding judge; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT this amendment to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m) shall not apply to cases already pending as of December 1, 2015, unless otherwise by the presiding judge, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Clerk is directed to post this General Order on the Court's Website.
