IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Local Rule 83.11, Trial Bar, be amended as follows (additions

LR83.11 Trial Bar

(k) Reinstatement. Any attorney who has withdrawn from membership in the trial bar pursuant to section (ij) but wishes to be reinstated must file a <u>new</u> petition for <u>admission to the trial bar and pay the</u> full current trial bar fee reinstatement with the eleck for presentation to the Executive Committee. Where the attorney was a member of a *pro bono* panel at the time the petition to withdraw was filed, the petition for reinstatement trial bar admission shall include a statement indicating the attorney's present willingness and ability to accept an assignment under LR83.35 through LR83.41. If the committee grants the motion in such an instance, it shall direct that the attorney be included in the *pro bono* panel and remain there for one year or until the attorney is assigned, whichever comes first.
