## Dear Dirksen Courthouse:

We recently learned that an employee/contractor, last in the Dirksen Courthouse yesterday (May 3) has tested positive for COVID-19. We understand this individual was on the 20<sup>th</sup> floor, but on no other floors of the buildings, wore a face covering for the entire time, and maintained appropriate distancing while in the Courthouse. We are notifying persons who had direct contact with this individual, and the General Services Administration will promptly clean the impacted areas.

As you may have heard, Mayor Lightfoot announced this morning that she expects to fully reopen the City of Chicago by July 4, if there is continued progress in Chicago's COVID-19 numbers. We can help to make this happen: even if you are fully vaccinated, please continue to adhere to the CDC's guidelines of wearing a mask, social distancing, and frequent handwashing. And even if you are fully vaccinated, you do need to continue to take your weekly/semi-weekly SHIELD test and review the results promptly.

Thanks again for your dedicated efforts. We will push on and do our best to stay safe and healthy, helping to keep our city on track for a July 4 reopening.
