**EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ORDER**

IT APPEARING THAT on August 13, 2014, Andrew Qureshi was found by Court Security Officers on the 23<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Dirksen U.S. Courthouse after the building had closed, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT Mr. Qureshi made several illogical statements to Court Security Officers, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT the Executive Committee has considered a memorandum from the United States Marshals Service regarding Mr. Qureshi's conduct, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT the Executive Committee finds that there is sufficient cause for concern regarding Mr. Qureshi's conduct if he is not barred from entering the Dirksen U.S. Courthouse, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT to maintain judicial security, Andrew Qureshi is barred from entering the Dirksen U.S. Courthouse, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT no sooner than twelve months from the date of this order, Andrew Qureshi may submit to the Executive Committee a motion to modify or rescind this order, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT a miscellaneous file with the title "In the matter of Andrew Qureshi" and case number 14 C 6440 shall serve as the repository of this order, and any order or minute order entered pursuant to this order. The Clerk will also maintain a miscellaneous docket associated with the file. All orders retained in the file will be entered on that docket following standard docketing procedures.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** THAT the Clerk shall cause a copy of this order to be mailed to Mr. Qureshi at [REDACTED], Chicago, Illinois 60618. Such mailing shall be by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested.
