Most of the cases have been dismissed due to reasons such as failure to comply with court orders, duplicate filing, failure to state a claim, frivolous nature of complaint, failure to pay filing fee, failure to exhaust all state court remedies, and Mr. Ellison's failure to advise the court that he has struck out.

It is the judgment of the Executive Committee that reasonable and necessary restraints must be imposed upon Mr. Ellison's ability to file new civil cases in this District *pro se*. Cases in existence prior to the entry of this order are not affected by this order and shall proceed as usual.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE in its capacity as the supervisor of the assignment of cases, that the clerk is directed to return unfiled any documents submitted either directly or indirectly by or on behalf of Bennie Ellison. A copy of this order shall be included with the returned documents, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That any password issued to Bennie Ellison for access to the electronic filing system shall be disabled, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Bennie Ellison is authorized to submit to this court, no earlier than twelve months from the date of this order, a motion to modify or rescind this order, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Nothing in this order shall be construed -----

- a) to affect Mr. Ellison's ability to defend himself in any criminal action,
- b) to deny Mr. Ellison access to the federal courts through the filing of a petition for a writ of habeas corpus or other extraordinary writ, or
- c) to deny Mr. Ellison access to the United States Court of Appeals or the United States Supreme Court, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Clerk shall cause to be created and maintained a miscellaneous file with the title "In the matter of Bennie Ellison " and case number 12 C 7356. The miscellaneous file shall serve as the repository of this order and any order or minute order entered pursuant to this order. The Clerk will also maintain a miscellaneous docket associated with the file. All orders retained in the file will be entered on that docket following standard docketing procedures. A brief entry will be made on the docket indicating the receipt of any materials from Mr. Ellison, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Clerk shall cause a copy of this order to be mailed to Mr. Ellison at [REDACTED] Joliet, Illinois 60434, the address given by Mr. Ellison in documents received on August 14, 2012. Such mailing shall be by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested.
