**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE** in its capacity as the supervisor of the assignment of cases, that the clerk is directed to return unfiled any papers submitted either directly or indirectly by or on behalf of Bettie Pullen-Walker. A copy of this order shall be included with the returned documents, and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That Bettie Pullen-Walker is authorized to submit to this court, no earlier than six months from the date of this order, a motion to modify or rescind this order, and


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That nothing in this order shall be construed -----

- a) to affect Ms. Pullen-Walker's ability to defend herself in any criminal action,
- b) to deny Ms. Pullen-Walker access to the federal courts through the filing of a petition for a writ of habeas corpus or other extraordinary writ, or
- c) to deny Ms. Pullen-Walker access to the United States Court of Appeals or the United States Supreme Court.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That the Clerk shall cause to be created and maintained a miscellaneous file with the title "In the matter of Bettie Pullen-Walker" and case number 08 C 3498. The miscellaneous file shall serve as the repository of this order, and any order or minute order entered pursuant to this order. The Clerk will also maintain a miscellaneous docket associated with the file. All orders retained in the file will be entered on that docket following standard docketing procedures.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That the Clerk shall cause a copy of this order to be mailed to Ms. Pullen-Walker at [REDACTED] Chicago, IL 60619, the address given by Ms. Pullen-Walker in documents submitted on June 4, 2008. Such mailing shall be by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested.
