GENERAL ORDER 14-0004
AMENDED**

By direction of the full court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That amended General Order 14-0004, entered on April 30, 2014 regarding the wearing of firearms in a courtroom be, and it hereby is, vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That no person other than the United States Marshal, Deputy United States Marshals, Court Security Officers, or Federal Law Enforcement Officers assigned full-time to agency-leased space at the Dirksen Courthouse shall wear or otherwise carry any firearms into the Everett McKinley Dirksen United States Courthouse..

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Federal law Enforcement Officers assigned full-time to agency-leased space in the Dirksen Courthouse may secure their weapons in their agency office in the Dirksen Courthouse, but may not carry them in any other area of the Courthouse.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That no person other than the United States Marshal, Deputy United States Marshals, or Court Security Officers shall wear or otherwise carry any firearms into any courtroom in the Everett McKinley Dirksen United States Courthouse.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That no person other than the United States Marshal, Deputy United States Marshals, or Court Security Officers shall wear or otherwise carry any firearms into the Stanley J. Roszkowski United States Courthouse.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the United States Marshal is hereby directed to enforce this order and in so doing take such steps as might be necessary to provide for a secure area for the deposit of firearms of all other law enforcement officers who wish or are required to be present in the Dirksen or Stanley J. Roszkowski Courthouse.
