

Proper Identification Required to Enter Court Facilities in Northern District of Illinois

In order to gain access to federal court facilities in the Northern District of Illinois, visitors must present valid unexpired government-issued identification pursuant to [General Order 15-0020](#).

Unexpired Illinois driver's licenses and Illinois identification cards are among acceptable forms of identification.

The U.S. Marshals Service will accept the following unexpired forms of identification:

- United States Passport and United States Passport Card
- Permanent resident card
- Department of Homeland Security enhanced driver's license
- Driver's license or other state photo identity card issued by Department of Motor Vehicles (or Equivalent), issued by any of the 50 United States, the District of Columbia, and the United States Territories of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, American Samoa and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands
- Department of Homeland Security Presidential Directive 12 (HSPD-12)
- Personal Identity Verification Cards
- Foreign government-issued passport, recognized by the Department of State
