

U.S. MAGISTRATE JUDGE - U.S. DISTRICT COURT

The United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois announces one or more vacancies for the position of United States magistrate judge in the Eastern Division. The Court is presently seeking applicants for these positions. These are full-time positions with an eight-year term of office and a duty station at the U.S. Courthouse in Chicago, Illinois.

One of these positions is a replacement for a retiring magistrate judge; the second position, when approved and funded, will be a newly-authorized magistrate judgeship.
