**EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ORDER**

Michael F. Henry has filed the following six cases in the Eastern Division of this District within the past twelve months as a *pro se* plaintiff:

- 07 C 5618, *Henry v. Gordon, et al.*
- 07 C 5649, *Henry v. Gavin, et al.*

On December 14, 2007, Michael F. Henry submitted correspondence to the court involving threats of violence, including deadly force, against government officials associated with 07 C 5649, *Henry v. Gavin, et al.* Henry was arrested by United States Marshals on the same date.

It is the judgment of the Executive Committee that reasonable and necessary restraints must be imposed upon Mr. Henry's ability to file new civil cases in this District *pro se*. Cases in existence prior to the entry of this order are not affected by this order.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE** in its capacity as the supervisor of the assignment of cases, that the Clerk is directed to return unfiled any papers submitted either directly or indirectly by or on behalf of Michael F. Henry. A copy of this order shall be included with the returned documents, and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That Michael F. Henry is authorized to submit to this court, no earlier than nine months from the date of this order, a motion to modify or rescind this order, and


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That nothing in this order shall be construed -----

- a) to affect Mr. Henry's ability to defend himself in any criminal action,
- b) to deny Mr. Henry access to the federal courts through the filing of a petition for a writ of habeas corpus or other extraordinary writ, or
- c) to deny Mr. Henry access to the United States Court of Appeals or the United States Supreme Court.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That the Clerk shall cause to be created and maintained a miscellaneous file with the title "In the matter of Michael F. Henry" and case number 07 C 7159. The miscellaneous file shall serve as the repository of this order, and any order or minute order entered pursuant to this order. The Clerk will also maintain a miscellaneous docket associated with the file. All orders retained in the file will be entered on that docket following standard docketing procedures.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** That the Clerk shall cause a copy of this order to be mailed to Mr. Henry at [REDACTED] Orland Park, Illinois 60462, the address given by Mr. Henry in each of the cases listed above. Such mailing shall be by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested.
