
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That no sooner than two years after the date of this order, Mr. Struck may submit a motion to rescind or modify this order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Clerk shall cause to be created and maintained a miscellaneous file with the title "In the matter of James T. Struck" and case number 12 C 0341. The miscellaneous file shall serve as the repository of this order and any order or minute order entered pursuant to this order. The Clerk will also maintain a miscellaneous docket associated with the file. All orders retained in the file will be entered on that docket following standard docketing procedures. A brief entry will be made on the docket indicating the receipt of any materials from Mr. Struck.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Clerk shall cause a copy of this order to be mailed to James T. Struck at [REDACTED] Chicago, Illinois 60645, the address given by Mr. Struck in papers filed on December 16, 2011. Such mailing shall be by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested.
