## UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF ILLINOIS AMENDED GENERAL ORDER 20-0001

On January 15, 2020, General Order 20-001 was entered directing that a number of actions take place in case number 69 CV 2145, *Shakman, et al v. Cook Co Democratic, et al.* The order allowed 21 days from the date of the order for parties to file objections. Two objections were filed (docket #6698 and #6768).

The Executive Committee has reviewed these objections and therefore orders the following:

- 1. Objection #6768 is denied as moot, as the filer is not a party to the case. Objection #6698 was filed by a party to the case and has not been withdrawn. Pursuant to that objection, the case will be reassigned.
- 2. The Clerk of Court is directed to immediately use the random case assignment wheel and draw the name of a district judge to be assigned to case number 69 CV 2145 at the end of Magistrate Judge Schenkier's term of office.
- 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to immediately use a random case assignment system of available magistrate judges as identified in General Order 20-0001 to be designated as the magistrate judge in case number 69 CV 2145 at the end of Magistrate Judge Schenkier's term of office.
- 4. The Clerk of Court is directed to immediately make a docket entry and identify the district and magistrate judges who will be assigned case number 69 CV 2145 and notify those judicial officers at that time.
- 5. The Clerk of Court is directed to reassign case number 69 CV 2145 on May 1, 2020 to the newly assigned district judge and designated magistrate judge.
