September 18, 2012. It recommended that the full Court adopt the proposal as published.

The full Court considered the recommendation of the Rules Committee at its meeting on

Thursday, September 27, 2012 and agreed to adopt Local Rule 16.4. Therefore,

By direction of the full Court, which met in executive session on Thursday, September 27, 2012,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Local Rule 16.4 Scheduling in Social Security Cases be

adopted as follows (additions shown thus, deletions shown thus):

LR16.4 Scheduling in Social Security Cases

In cases brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for benefits under the Social Security Act, the following schedule is established unless otherwise ordered:

(a) Plaintiff's brief in support of reversing or remanding the decision subject to review is due within 60 days of the filing of the answer and administrative record (no motion required).

(b) The Social Security Administration's motion to affirm the decision subject to review and its brief in support are due 45 days after plaintiff's brief is filed.

(c) Plaintiff's reply brief, if any, is due 14 days after defendant's brief is filed.
