## LR 7.1. Briefs: Page Limit

Neither <u>a motion nor</u> a brief in support of or in opposition to any motion, nor objections to a report and recommendation or order of a magistrate judge or special master, shall exceed 15 pages without prior approval of the court. Briefs that exceed the 15 page limit must have a table of contents with the pages noted and a table of cases. Any brief or objection that does not comply with this rule shall be filed subject to being stricken by the court.
