ORDER

Scott Richard Dinin was admitted to practice before the General Bar of this Court on October 6, 2014. On July 2, 2020, the Supreme Court of Florida entered an order suspending Scott Richard Dinin from the practice of law for eighteen (18) months, with conditions, effective July 6, 2020; and the Executive Committee being fully advised in the premises.

The Committee finds that the Citation ordering Scott Richard Dinin to inform this Court within fourteen (14) days of receipt of said Citation, of any claim, predicated upon the grounds set forth in Local Rule 83.26(e), that the imposition of discipline by this Court, identical to that imposed by the Supreme Court of Florida, would be unwarranted and the reasons therefore, was served on Scott Richard Dinin by certified mail; and that Scott Richard Dinin failed to answer within said time.

IT IS ORDERED that Scott Richard Dinin is suspended from the practice of law in this District for eighteen (18) months effective July 6, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within twenty-one (21) days of the docketing of this order, Scott Richard Dinin shall notify by certified mail, return receipt requested, all clients to whom Scott Richard Dinin is responsible for pending matters before this Court of the fact that the attorney cannot continue to represent them.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT any password issued to Scott Richard Dinin for access to the electronic filing system shall be disabled until the attorney is reinstated to active status with this District.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty-five (35) days of the entry of this order, Scott Richard Dinin shall file with the Assistant to the Clerk of the Court a declaration indicating the address to which subsequent communications may be addressed; and shall keep and maintain records evidencing compliance with this order so that proof of compliance will be available if needed for any subsequent proceeding instituted by or against the attorney.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall post this Order on the docket in every pending case in which the attorney has filed an attorney appearance.
