C O R R E C T E D O R D E R

It appearing that Jeffrey Joseph Keck was admitted to practice before the general bar of this Court on December 14, 1978 and the trial bar of this Court on November 1, 1982; that on September 21, 2015, the Illinois Supreme Court entered an order disbaring Jeffrey Joseph Keck; and the Executive Committee being fully advised in the premises;

The Committee finds that the Citation ordering Jeffrey Joseph Keck to inform this Court within fourteen (14) days of receipt of said Citation, of any claim by the attorney, predicated upon the grounds set forth in Local Rule 83.26(e), that the imposition of discipline by this Court, identical to that imposed by the Illinois Supreme Court, would be unwarranted and the reasons therefore, was served upon Jeffrey Joseph Keck by certified mail; and that Jeffrey Joseph Keck failed to respond within said time.;

IT IS ORDERED that Jeffrey Joseph Keck is disbarred from the practice of law in this District.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within twenty-one (21) days of the docketing of this order, Jeffrey Joseph Keck shall notify by certified mail, return receipt requested, all clients to whom the attorney is responsible for pending matters before this Court of the fact that the attorney cannot continue to represent them.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT any password issued to Jeffrey Joseph Keck for access to the electronic filing system shall be disabled until the attorney is reinstated to active status with this District.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty-five (35) days of the entry of this order, Jeffrey Joseph Keck shall file with the Clerk of the Court a declaration stating that the attorney has so notified any clients, and indicating the address to which subsequent communications may be addressed; and shall keep and maintain records evidencing compliance with this order so that proof of compliance will be available if needed for any subsequent proceeding instituted by or against the attorney.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall post this Order on the docket in every pending case in which the attorney has filed an attorney appearance.
