ORDER

It appearing that Vincent DeMarti Porter was admitted to practice before the General Bar of this Court on February 24, 2011; that on September 21, 2020, the Illinois Supreme Court entered an order disbaring Vincent DeMarti Porter; and the Executive Committee being fully advised in the premises;

The Committee finds that the Citation ordering Vincent DeMarti Porter to inform this Court within fourteen (14) days of receipt of said Citation, of any claim by the attorney, predicated upon the grounds set forth in Local Rule 83.26(e), that the imposition of discipline by this Court, identical to that imposed by the Illinois Supreme Court, would be unwarranted and the reasons therefor, was served upon Vincent DeMarti Porter by certified mail; and that Vincent DeMarti Porter filed a response indicating his opposition to the imposition of identical discipline. Vincent Demarti Porter asked that the Committee refrain from imposing discipline at this time.

IT IS ORDERED that Vincent DeMarti Porter's request is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Vincent DeMarti Porter is disbarred from the practice of law in this District.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within twenty-one (21) days of the docketing of this order, Vincent DeMarti Porter shall notify by certified mail, return receipt requested, all clients to whom the attorney is responsible for pending matters before this Court of the fact that the attorney cannot continue to represent them.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any password issued to Vincent DeMarti Porter for access to the electronic filing system shall be disabled until the attorney is reinstated to active status with this District.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty-five (35) days of the entry of this order, Vincent DeMarti Porter shall file with the Clerk of the Court a declaration stating that the attorney has so notified any clients, and indicating the address to which subsequent communications may be addressed; and shall keep and maintain records evidencing compliance with this order so that proof of compliance will be available if needed for any subsequent proceeding instituted by or against the attorney.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should the September 21, 2020 Illinois Supreme Court disbarment be overturned, Vincent DeMarti Porter may notify the Executive Committee.
