

Judge Beth W. Jantz was previously an attorney with the Federal Defender Program for the Northern District of Illinois. The FDP provides free representation to legally indigent persons accused of committing a wide variety of federal crimes. Judge Jantz represented clients throughout the entire course of criminal cases, including trials and appeals.

Before that, Judge Jantz practiced at Sidley Austin LLP in Chicago, focusing on class actions and products liability. Judge Jantz also clerked for the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals' Staff Attorneys' Office.

Judge Jantz served on many court committees and in several bar associations, including as the President of the Chicago Inn of Court for 2019-20, the Board of Governors for the 7th Circuit Bar Association, and as a member of the 7th Circuit Criminal Jury Instructions Committee and the 7th Circuit Advisory Committee on Circuit Rules. She has also taught and lectured both locally and nationally on e-discovery, electronic case management and review, and mobile and digital devices and data.
